

# THE ROSEDALE RAMBLE SCENIC RUN

(Duration Approx – 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> hrs. without stops)

A run of about 50 miles featuring many single track roads and some gated ones. It is suggested that you fill up before starting the route as fuel stations are scarce up on the moors. The distances are as accurate as the average Morgan odometer!

Please give consideration and space to walkers, cyclists and sheep, (not necessarily in that order)!

Villages through which the route passes are named, so if in doubt just press on to the next named village. ***Have a great day!***

**Please do not form convoys, leave gaps in order that faster vehicles may pass.**

30.0	GROSMONT is the Northern end of the North Yorkshire Moors Railway. Steam trains run on a regular timetable to the terminus at Pickering. Cross over the railway line	0.1
30.2	TURN RIGHT SP Goathland, Pickering <b>CARE</b> 1:3 gradient	0.2
32.2	To your left – The North Sea & Whitby	2.0
32.3	T JUNCTION - TURN RIGHT SP Pickering, A169	0.1
32.4	On horizon to your left at ‘ 11o’clock ‘ is RAF Fylingdales - radar station Opened in 1963 as a ballistic missile early warning system. Originally 3 golf-ball shaped radars – replaced in 1980 by current structure, a cross between an Aztec temple and a huge Toblerone chunk. It still does not appear on civilian maps.	0.1
32.6	TURN RIGHT SP Goathland, Beck Hole	0.2
34.5	Cross North Yorkshire Moors Railway. Look RIGHT over bridge – Goathland Station	1.9
34.6	Enter Goathland Toilets, Tea Rooms Goathland is the village where ‘Heartbeat’ is filmed. A Yorkshire Centre Morgan featured in a recent episode.	0.1
35.5	TURN RIGHT SP Egton Bridge, Roman Road	0.9
38.9	TURN LEFT – single track road, weak road, gated road - no SP	3.4
39.4	T JUNCTION – TURN LEFT no SP	0.5
42.2	FORD	2.8
43.6	<i>Another</i> FORD	1.4
44.7	Gate	1.1
45.9	<i>Yet another</i> FORD	1.2
47.7	TURN RIGHT SP Cropton	1.8
51.6	T JUNCTION – TURN LEFT no SP	3.9
